

Summary of Volunteer Positions for Returning Hearts Celebration  
April 14, 2012 at Walker Faith and Character-Based Prison  
Deadline to sign up is March 31, 2012

As a volunteer, your job is to care, sacrifice, serve, instruct, protect, direct, guide and be accountable.

**Family Assistant** – As a family assistant, you will be assigned to a family that you will be with for the entire day. You will be a bag holder, prayer partner, lunch server and helper. ALWAYS point the father to the child and the child to the father. Your role is to SERVE the family by:

- Staying with the family the entire day
- Monitoring/facilitating conversation if needed
- Being a fun, enthusiastic, loving presence to dad and kids
- Assisting at lunch by carrying trays or holding bags
- Accompanying children to the restroom if needed

In general, you must be able to:

- Stand on your feet for long periods of time
- Be able to withstand heat
- Be sincerely interested in SERVING a family
- Be willing to stay with your family AT ALL TIMES
- Be 18 years or older

**Volunteer Check-in** – Provide instructions as to volunteer duties, supplies needed, registration procedures, etc. Oversee wristband and t-shirt distribution at check-in.

**Family Check-in**

Volunteers will check-in children, match them to Family Assistants

**Exit crew** –Set up stations with take home items (granola bars, soda, cheese and crackers, fresh fruit) for kids to take for car ride home.

**Photographer** –Need at least 2 photographers to take family photos.

**Volunteer Relief Team** – Stay with family when Family Assistant requests a break.

**Fun Fair/Crafts** – Volunteers will run fair games. Crafts – Volunteers will encourage dads and children to work together on craft projects

**Inflatable Games/Basketball** – Volunteers will monitor inflatable games. Volunteers will monitor the basketball courts and encourage friendly pick up games.

**Guardian Program** – Volunteers with a passion for the guardians of the children attending the event will serve food, greet guardians and assist with the program.
